1 Rules

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Australian Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024.
- 1.2. Vic Port Corporation 11th edition May 2019 in particular Section 2.14 Page 20 applies to this event <http://www.vicports.vic.gov.au/publications/Documents/hm-directions-10th-edition.pdf>
All skippers are required to be conversant with the responsibilities outlined in section's 2.14 and 5 of this document
- 1.3. RRS Racing rule 44.1 will be changed as follows:
The two turn penalty is replaced with a one turn penalty.
This change will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions of all Cup Regatta races.

2 Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3 Eligibility and entry

- 3.1. The 2021/2022 Cup Regatta series of races is open to Classic Yachts and Coutu Boats as determined by the CYAA Executive and are registered with a Keel Boat Yacht Club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
- 3.2. Entrants must complete, sign and submit the 2021/2022 Cup Regatta entry form to the Classic Yacht Association of Australia (CYAA), by COB Wednesday 17th February 2022.
- 3.3. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organising authority.
- 3.4. There are no restrictions on the number of boats to enter.

4 Classification

- 4.1. No classification requirement applies to the 2021/2022 Cup Regatta.

5 Fees

- 5.1. All race entry \$100.00. Individual Race Entry \$25.00 per race.
- 5.2. Optional social event fees TBA at a later date.

6 Qualifying series and finals.

- 6.1. No qualifying or final series races will apply to the 2021/2022 Cup Regatta

7 Schedule

- 7.1. 2022 Cup Regatta Entries required by 17th February 2022
- 7.2. No classic yacht measurement or inspection will be scheduled for the 2021/2022 Cup Regatta.
- 7.3. Date of racing.
All divisions 19th to 20th February 2022. No lay day scheduled
- 7.4. Number of races.
All Classes 2 races each day.
- 7.5. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1025 hours.

8 Measurements

8.1. No measurement certificates are required for the 2021/2022 Cup Regatta.

9 Sailing Instructions

9.1. The sailing instructions will be available after 16th February 2022 on the CYAA web site.

10 The Courses

10.1. The courses to be sailed will be described in the sailing instructions

11 Penalty System

11.1. The penalties are as follows for all divisions.

11.2. For all divisions rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty

12 Scoring

12.1. The scoring system is as follows

12.2. Two races are required to constitute a series.

12.3. When two or more races have been completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.

13 Support Boats

13.1. Support boats will be marked with a RYCV burgee.

14 Radio Communications

14.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receiver radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

15 Prizes

15.1. Subject to at least three boats starting with further determination and subject to entries received, the following Trophies shall be awarded such time decided by the organizers.

15.2. **COL BANDY TROPHY** Awarded to the Regatta's Champion Classic Yacht with the lowest aggregated points score for all the 2021/2022 Cup Regatta conducted races.

15.3. **STRADBROKE II TROPHY** Awarded to the Regatta's Couta Boat with the lowest overall aggregated point score for all 2021/2022 Cup Regatta conducted races.

15.4. **TONY BLAKE PERPETUAL TROPHY.** The trophy deed of gift stipulates a copy of the perpetual trophy be awarded to the Classic Yacht with the best performing points score aggregated Over the 2021/2022 Cup Regatta and over the immediate past Summer and Winter Series. Double performance points score is activated for Cup Regatta events.

15.5. **CONCOURS d'ELEGANCE TROPHY** for the smartest and ship shape Classic Yacht that competed in the 2021/2022 Cup Regatta.

16 Disclaimer of Liability

16.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority and Ports Victoria will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 Insurance

17.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or equivalent.
